

POLICY REGARDING SOCIAL EVENTS IN MILL CREEK

TO HOLD A COMMUNITY SOCIAL EVENT:

1. A written proposal for any community social event in Mill Creek must be presented to the Board for its approval before the event can take place.
2. Any proposal must include the specific time the event will begin and the length, location, and type of event.
3. The event will be approved only if the person or committee proposing the event obtains the consent of all residents who would be directly affected by the event (by noise, by access to their unit or driveway, etc.).
4. If the event will disrupt traffic, barricades such as orange cones or standard road-hazard sandwich boards must be used to caution drivers and pedestrians and to prevent injuries. The Board has those items available.
5. The person or committee proposing the activity is responsible for ending the event at the designated time.
